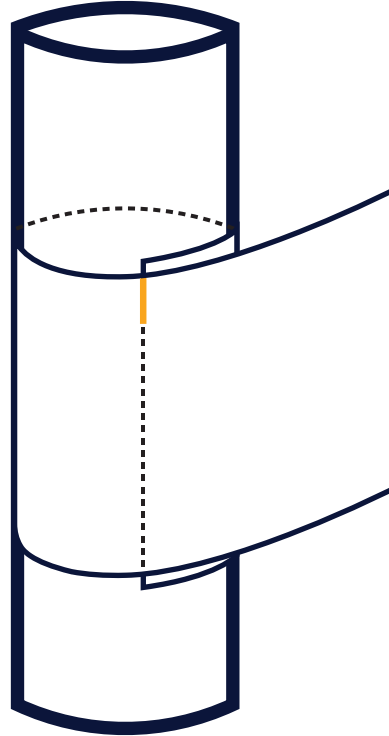




How to Measure to Get Clamp Size



Take a sheet of paper and wrap it around the pipe you would like the clamp to attach to. Mark where the paper sheet overlaps itself with a writing utensil. From there, lay the paper sheet out flat and use a ruler to measure the distance from the end of the paper to the mark. By looking at the key below, you can determine the clamp size needed based on the measurement you collected.

2.75" = .875" outside diameter of pipe = 7/8" clamp

3.14" = 1" outside diameter of pipe = 1" clamp

4.18" = 1.33" outside diameter of pipe = 1.33" clamp

5.22" = 1.66" outside diameter of pipe = 1.66" clamp

6.0" = 1.9" outside diameter of pipe = 1.9" clamp

6.28" = 2" outside diameter of pipe = 2" clamp

7.46" = 2.375" outside diameter of pipe = 2.375" clamp
